Focusing on geographic themes such as size, climate and terrain, this series compares the experiences of children living in the UK to contrasting places

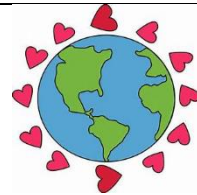
