

# Words with 'soft c' spelt with 'ci'



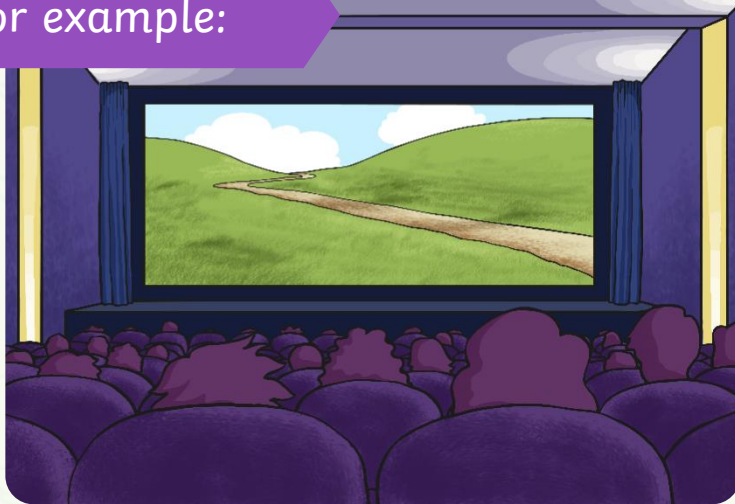
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This week, we are looking at words that have a 'soft c'.  
A 'soft c' makes an /s/ sound.



This can mean that some words that may sound like they start with an 's' can actually begin with the letter 'c'.

For example:



**c**inema

If the second letter of a word that starts with an /s/ sound is an 'e', 'i' or 'y', the sound **could** in fact be made with a 'c'!

This week, we are going to concentrate on words that have a 'soft c' sound spelt with 'ci' like 'cinema'.

We are going to play 'Say What You See'. Can you work with a partner to figure out which 'soft c' spelt using 'ci' word is hiding behind the numbered squares?

**Remember:** the 'soft c' sound doesn't always have to be at the beginning of the word!
