



Mrs Wait, Mrs Terrett, Mrs Colvin and Mrs Foster are in here to help.





#### Other areas around school




Art Room

- 2. Find a friend to talk to or help you find the help you need.

If I need help around the school, I can:

- 1. Ask a friend
- 2. Ask another child
- 3. Ask any adult to help me

If I need help with my work I could:

- 1. Think about what the teacher said.
- 2. Check the white board to remind me.
- 3. Check what everyone else is doing.
- 4. Use resources on my table and in the classroom to help me.
- 5. Put my hand up and ask.
