

A map of our school




The Beach Hut and The Hub (ELSA Room)

This room and the Small Hall are used for class and individual music lessons.


Other areas around school

This is also where the PTA hold film nights and discos.








The Small Hall

First Aid room



This is right at the front of the school. You only need to come into school this way if you are late or if you are returning after an appointment. You only come to the First Aid Room if an adult has sent you or you need medicine whilst in school.

- 1. Think about what the teacher said.
- 2. Check the white board to remind me.
- Check what everyone else is doing.
- 4. Use resources on my table and in the classroom to help me.
- 5. Put my hand up and ask.
