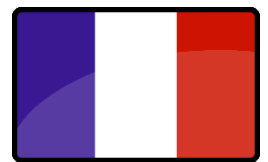
Surveying our local area

We have been learning how to greet each other in French. Ask us how to say hello and how are you?

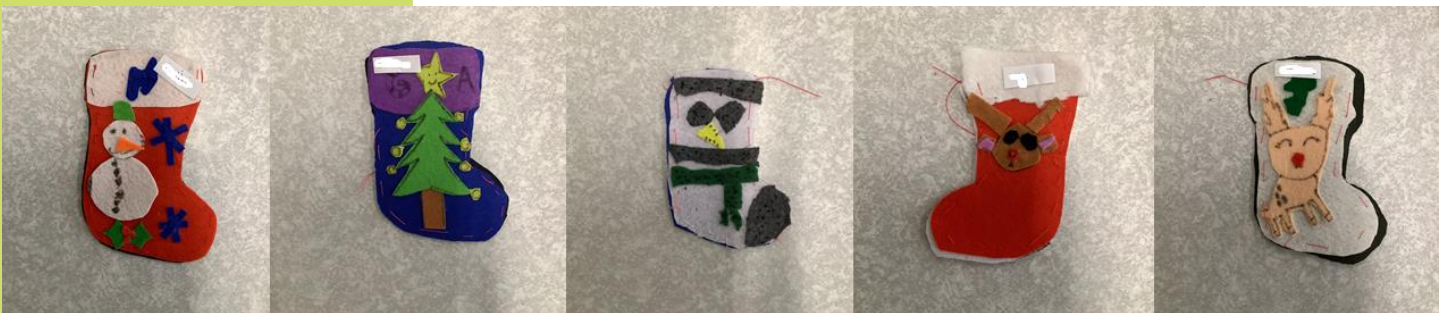


Swimming at Mountbatten Leisure Centre
