The information we send out about the curriculum and events is being missed or isn't clear enough, so we are going to:

- Try to get a better emailing service; ours is too limited.
- Review the format of our curriculum and events letters so they are easier to read.
- Schedule more information workshops, at different times of the day.
- Keep using social media for updates.

ENRICHMENT

Wider variety of clubs, experiences and visits.

Costs are a big factor. We can't afford to pay for a lot without parent contributions (e.g. currently there is deficit of £3000 for swimming; we can't then subsidise more unpaid trips). So, we are going to:

- Put together a plan of enrichment for each year group, with more experiences and visits, with a total cost, in advance.
- Try to source more volunteers for clubs and CLACA events, as well as paid clubs from companies.
