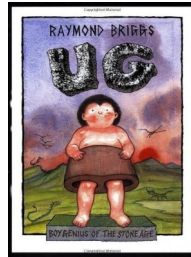

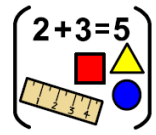
English

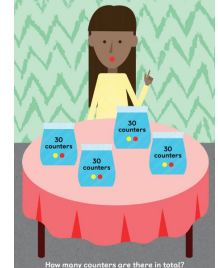

PE

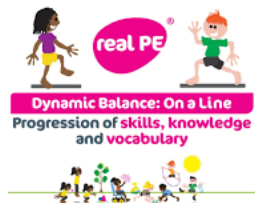


Our indoor PE will be introducing Dynamic Balance and we will be developing ball skills and co-ordination.

In our outdoor PE, we will be learning the skills for tennis.

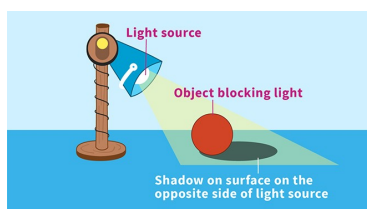

In Science, we are looking at Light. We will be exploring how we need light to see. We will be looking at how different materials let light through and how it reflects off some objects.

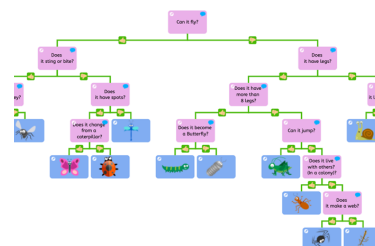

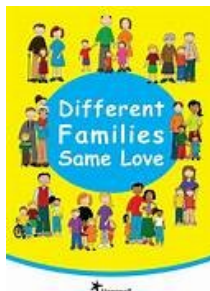


PSHE

Art

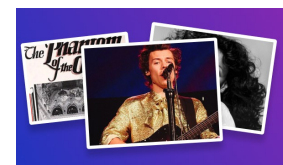
In Art this half term, we will be looking at colour and printmaking. This will also link to our history topic as we will be exploring Stone Age art.
