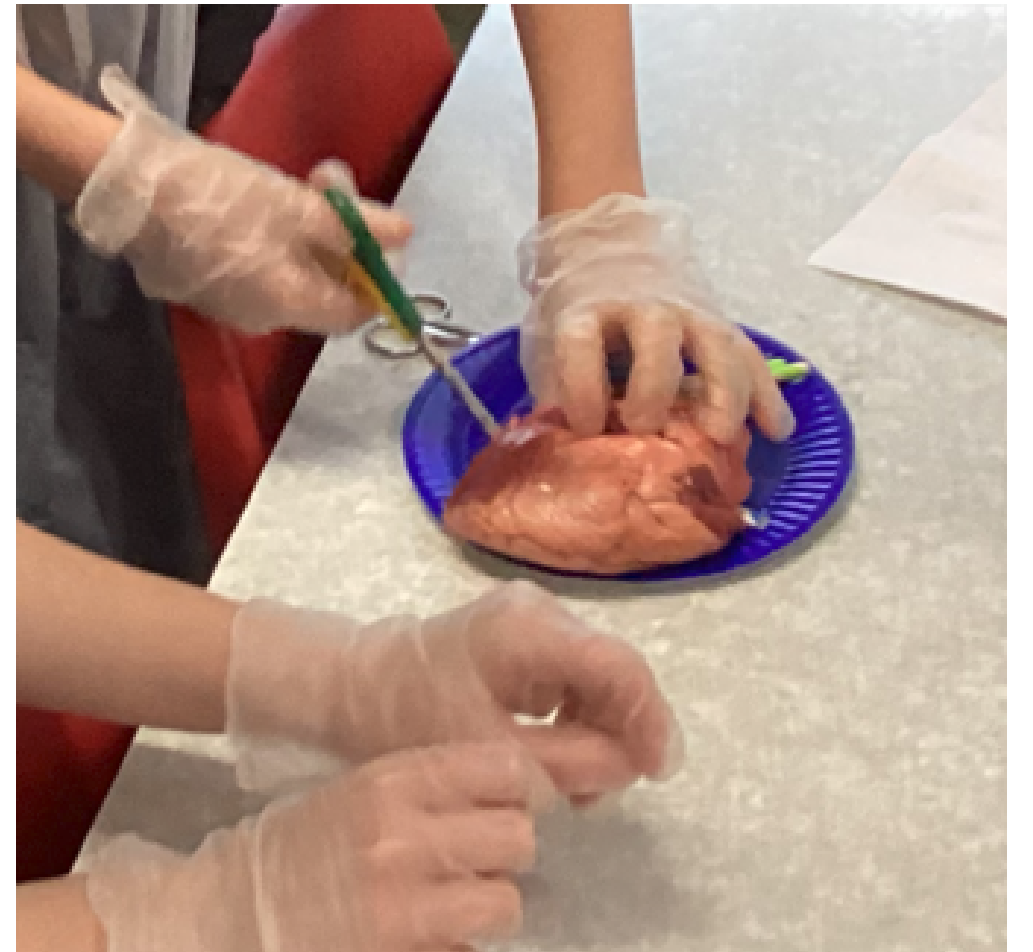


YEAR 6 SPRING TERM

After learning about the circulatory system last term, children had the opportunity to explore practically through a real dissection of a lamb's heart.



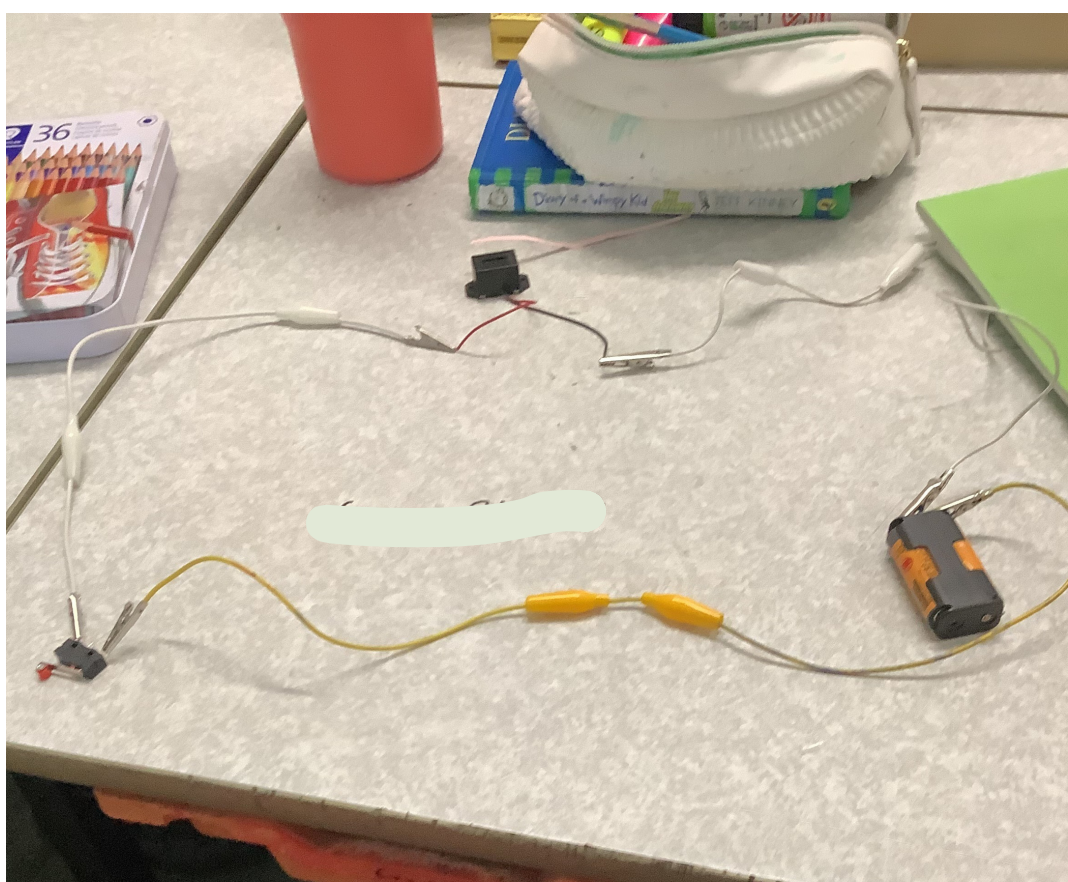
COMPUTING

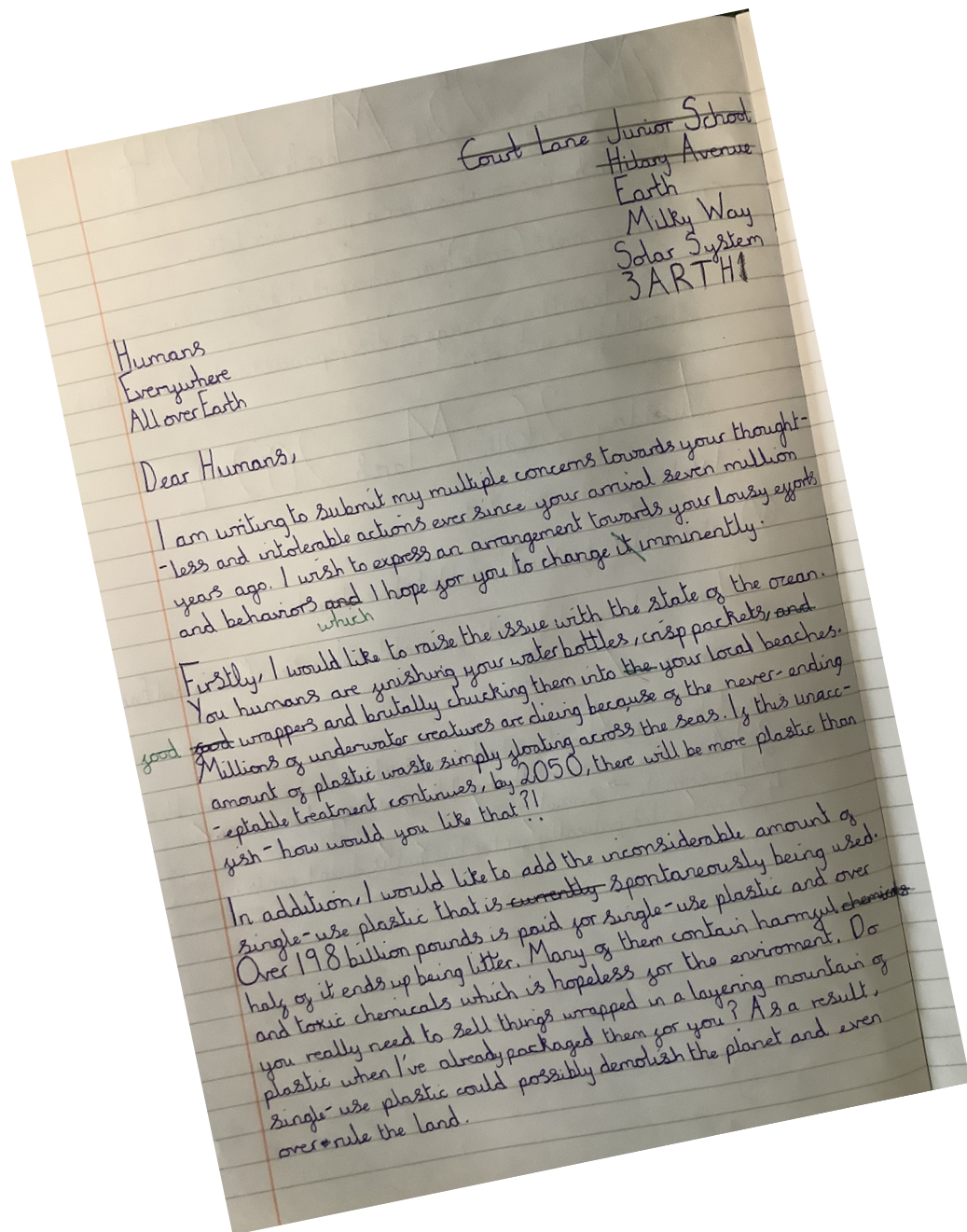
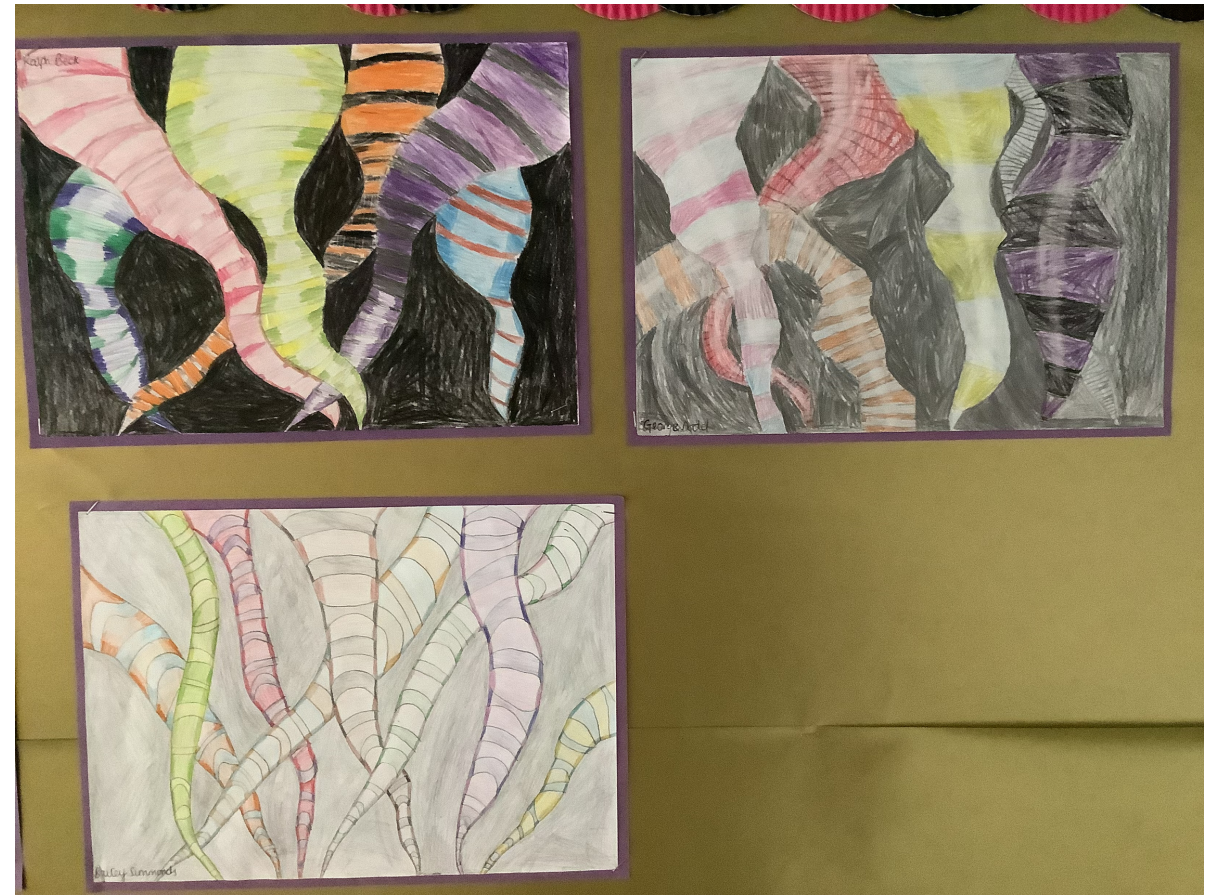


DT AND SCIENCE
