If children bring in fruit, e.g grapes, please ensure that they are cut up at home. Water bottles should only contain water, not juice or squash.

Please also remember we have a strict NO NUTS policy at Court Lane. In order to safeguard the children who are at risk from anaphylactic shock we have banned chocolate spread, peanuts and nut related products. Please do not put any of these items in your child's lunch box.
