## Contact numbers and parental arrangements

Please remember to update us with any new numbers you may have so that we can ensure we can contact you throughout the school day. Equally, if there are regular people who can pick up your child, please ensure the class teacher knows and that this information is on the contact form. For some parents we appreciate that families may have differing arrangements but we need to be aware of these to action them appropriately. If there are any court orders in place or there are orders that have now been changed, please arrange to meet with Mrs Ramshaw or Mrs Geddes to ensure that we are fully aware of current court expectations. Any parent who has parental responsibility can have information about their child's education unless there are orders that prevent this. We can discuss and accommodate split family arrangements to facilitate these in school, especially regarding educational reports and parent consultation evenings.

## Parking Arrangements

We politely ask all parents/carers to respect our neighbours when parking in the roads surrounding the schools. Please **do not** park over drives or on both sides of roads stopping the flow of traffic. The yellow zig zag lines outside our school must be left clear at all times so 'stop to drop' **must not** happen outside our gates or on the zig-zag lines. We have been advised once again that the local PCSOs will be making random checks at drop off and pick up, ticketing parents parking illegally.

## Safety & Security

Whilst we actively encourage healthy travelling to school, please can I remind all our community that scooting or cycling on either site is not permitted to keep us all safe. Can I also remind you that dogs should neither be on site nor tied to gates posts on pavements around the schools. We have had a few new near misses with energetic children streaming out at the end of the day and dogs getting over excited and snappy. May I take this opportunity to remind parents that all visitors to either school, should report to either school reception.

## **Uniform**

May I also express my thanks to parents for your support with our school uniform policy. The children look fantastic as we begin the new term. Our uniform is a key part of our sense of community and we are committed to maintaining these high standards throughout the year. In an effort to reduce lost property, please label and keep checking that names inside of school clothes have not been washed away.

## **Parent Surgery**

We are pleased to let you know that we will be able to offer an opportunity for families who may require some support with the many issues that you face as parents, particularly regarding children's behaviour. A flyer will be sent to you in due course with further information. A Portsmouth City Council Specialist Parenting Worker will be running these sessions independently of school. They will be held in the Community building at the back of the Junior School from 9am-12pm on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> October, Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> November and Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> December. ## **Welcome back**

## **Staff Update**

You will be aware that we are looking to recruit a new Cover Supervisor, this is because Mr Hicking will be leaving us at the end of this half term as he moving to Nottingham. We will all be very sad to see him go and I am sure we will have our own memories of him. ## **Equipment for school**

Thank you to all families for ensuring that the children have returned to school with their book bags and PE kits. If you are yet to bring in your child's PE kit we ask that you do this urgently as the children have started PE lessons in school. Children who have their ears pierced must have their own tape in their PE bags to cover their earrings during PE, without the tape they will not be able to participate. We note that many children do have book bags so we thank you for not sending in larger bags as this means that the management within the classrooms is easier as space is limited.

## **Mealtimes**

Please help us by encouraging your child to eat with cutlery at home. In school the children have support with cutting up their food, but with 360 children to get through dinner in just over an hour it would help if the children could cut up some food for themselves. Many of the meals need to be eaten with cutlery and not fingers so please encourage this at home. In addition, please discuss meal choices at home so that the children have considered this before they come to school.

## **Parent library**

In school we have some books in the library that can be borrowed by parents/carers that cover some issues that may be experienced at home. These books can be used to open up discussions at home with your children. If you are interested in borrowing these, there is a list available on the school website with a link found under the 'parents'

section. If at any time you wish to seek further support with issues that you may be experiencing with your child please contact the school office and ask for a member of the leadership or pastoral team.
