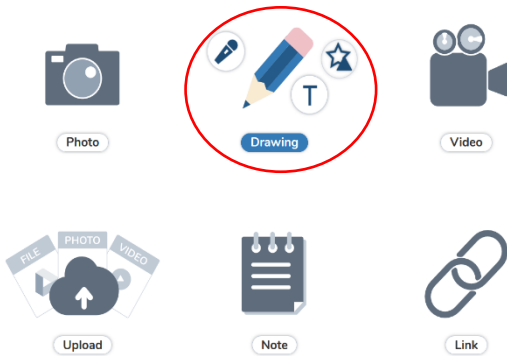


# Tips for uploading responses on Seesaw

## Drawing:



If there is not a worksheet for you to work on, you can create your own response using the 'Drawing' tool.

When you open the drawing screen, you will see these options:

**T** will add a text box for you to type. If you click on the 3 dots underneath the text box, you will get these options:

Remove the outline from the text box

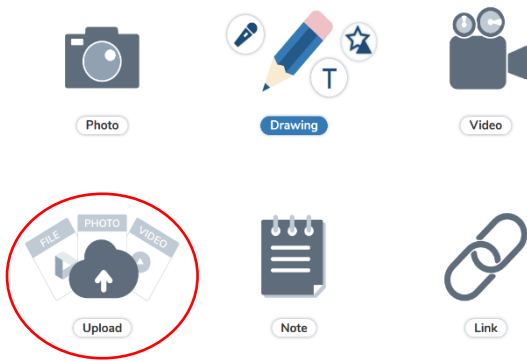
Add the outline to the text box

Add a background to the text box

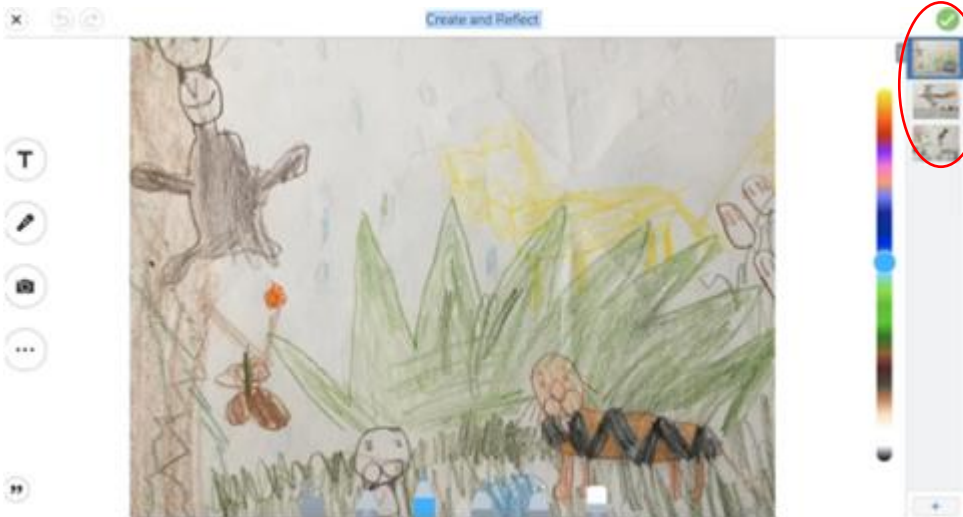
You can add shapes, maths symbols and dienes

You can change the background colour OR make the background squared (for maths), lined, dotted etc.

## Upload:

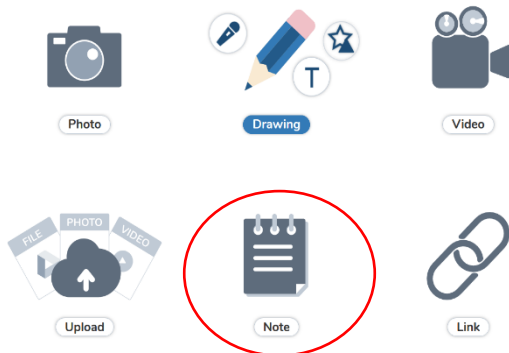


You can upload up to 10 photos, 1 PDF (if you have scanned in your work or worked on the computer) or 1 video at a time.

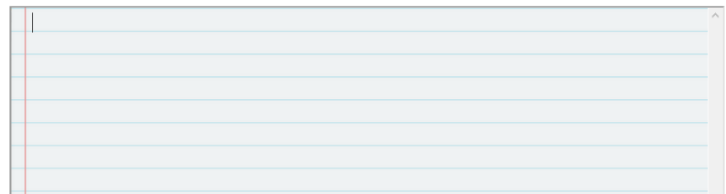


Each photo will appear on a different page, where you can access all of the drawing tools mentioned above. For instance, if you are writing a story, you could draw a picture for each different page, then record yourself telling the story. Just click on “ to record your voice on each page.

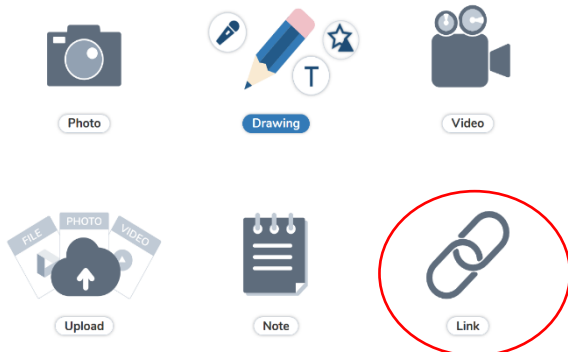
## Note:
